A.L.L. is a volunteer and self-governing organization guided by an Executive Board. Planning for classes is done by A.L.L. members twice a year at scheduled open meetings.

Our classes encompass a myriad of topics, such as architecture, art, history, poetry, politics and religion. The curriculum also provides courses for entertainment, such as the classic movie series. Field trips to art galleries, studios, museums and historic sites are also an integral part of each semester's lifelong learning agenda.

Classes are offered five days a week during day time hours on the campus of Three Rivers Community College.

Occasionally a program is offered off campus.

Fall semester classes are held in October and November; spring semester classes are held in April and May.
